We've included some materials to use and decorate, but the activities can be done using household leftovers - egg boxes, plastic bottles, milk bottle cartons, toilet and kitchen rolls etc. - please ask an adult to check it is OK for you to use any of the materials.

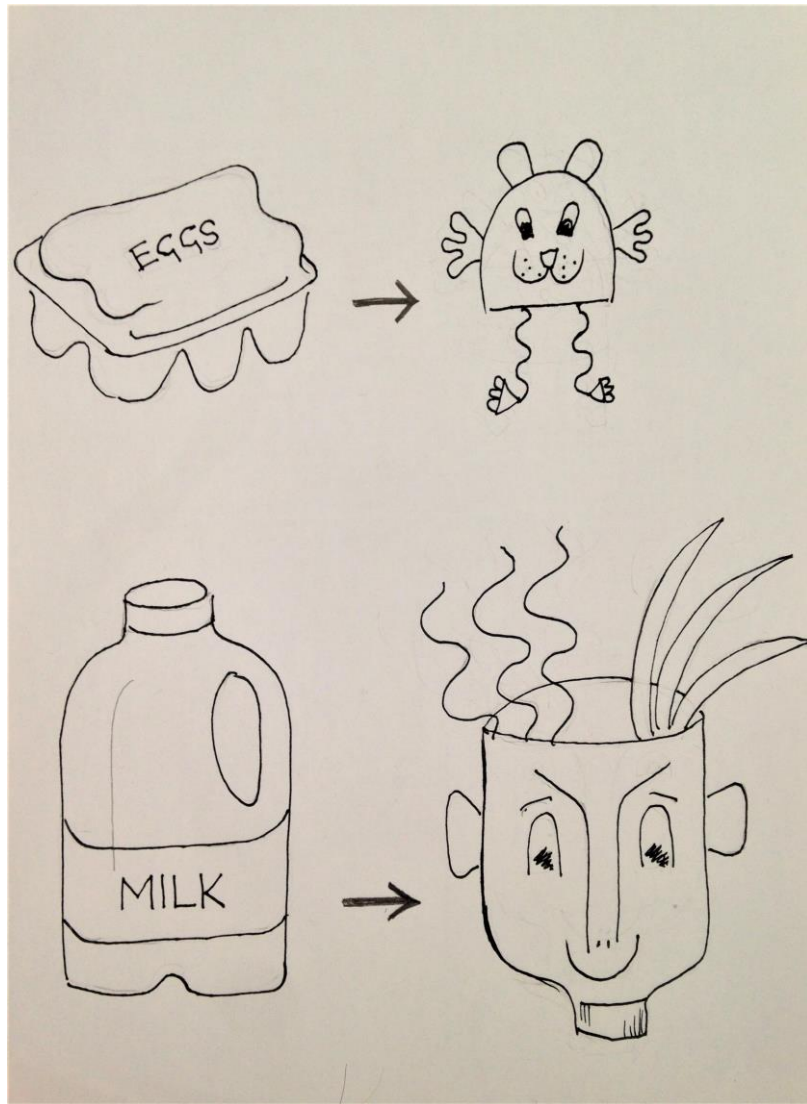
As usual, of course, if you have your own ideas of things, animals, people, mechanics to make, that's GREAT and please go for it!
You can Re - Cycle and Up - Cycle to create creatures, plants, towers, buildings, and anything else that you may think of from your own imagination.

SECOND ACTIVITY SESSION

Egg Carton Mouse Head

Or any other type of creature. You could make a whole world of egg box creatures...

1. Cut out the pieces of the egg carton that the eggs sit in.
2. With the extra cardboard you can cut out some ears which can be stuck on the back.
3. Create a face to bring it to life.
4. Legs can be made from pipe cleaners...
5. Hands from cutting out extra card or paper.



Milk Carton Head (or any other animal)

- 1.** Cut the base off the milk carton.
 - 2.** Turn upside down with the handle facing you, you may be able to imagine the handle as a long nose.
 - 3.** Create a face and as hair you could use the pipe cleaners or paper or card, (see picture).
 - 4.** You could also attach string to either side of the head for it hang somewhere.
- It would make a great container to keep any light art materials you may have!
